



Music CD Agreement

Anyone who is at least 18 years old, has a valid library card from a Bridges member library, and is in good standing with that card, may check out Music CDs. Persons younger than 18 require permission by a parent or legal guardian in order to check out Music CDs. A signature by a parent or legal guardian is required on the minor's library card application. It is the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian to monitor Music CD materials checked out to a minor.

Please be advised: The Library is not responsible for damages that may occur to equipment in the playing of CD materials. Music CDs owned and loaned by the Library are for private, in-home use only and are protected by copyright law.

Music CDs are checked out for fourteen (14) days. There is no limit on the number that can be checked out. Three renewals are allowed provided there are no current holds on the item (s). Overdue charges are .50 per day, **no** grace period.

Music CDs must be returned inside or in the 24/7 media return at the Jefferson Public Library: *do not* return them in outside materials receptacles. While the item(s) are in your possession, they are your responsibility. You may be liable for damages to the CDs up to full replacement value. Please report any problems with CDs to staff.
